HOME DEPARTMENT Sachivalaya, Gandhinagar. Dated the 13th January, 2016

Prisons Act, 1894. No. GG-03/2016/JLM/502008/4807/J:- In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (10) of section 59 read with section 6 of the Prisons Act, 1894 (9 of 1894) and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Government of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Jailor Group-II (Male), Class III, in the subordinate service of the Jail Department, namely:-

- 1. These rules may be called the Jailor Group-II (Male), Class III, Recruitment Rules, 2015.
- 2. Appointment to the post of Jailor Group-II (Male), Class III, in the subordinate service of the Jail Department shall be made either,
 - (a) by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the persons who, -
 - (i) have worked for not less than five years in the cadre of Subedar (Male),Class III, in the subordinate service of the Jail Department;
 - (ii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006:

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience as specified in sub-clause (i) above is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up the post by promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period; it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two-thirds of the period specified in sub-clause (i) above; or

- (b) by direct selection.
- Appointment by promotion and by direct selection shall be made in the ratio of 1:1.
- 4. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule
 2, a candidate shall,
 - (a) not be less than 21 years and more than 35 years of age:

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate belonging to the Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes or Socially and Educationally Backward Classes or who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions

of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967 : .

Provided further that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Jail Department to the extent of five years;

- (b) possess a degree obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act 1956; or possess an equivalent qualification recognised as such by the Government;
- have fulfilled the requisite criteria of physical standards as prescribed in Appendix 'A' appended to these rules;
- (d) possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;
- (e) have passed the physical efficiency test as may be prescribed by the Government; and
- (f) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi:

Provided that the preference may be given to the candidate who possesses 'C' level **c**ertificate of National Cadet Corps.

- Notwithstanding anything contained in any rules, a candidate selected under rule 4 shall be appointed on contract basis for a period of five years on such terms and conditions as prescribed by the Government Resolution, Home Department No:JLM–502008–4807-J dated 13/01/2016.
- 6. A candidate appointed in accordance with rule 4 shall be given the prescribed pay scale of the post of Jailor Group-II, (Male) Class-III, after completion of contractual period on his performance being found satisfactory during the stipulated period of service on contractual basis.
- 7. A candidate appointed in accordance with rule 4 shall during the stipulated period of service on contractual basis, be required to pass the CCC examination for computer knowledge as prescribed by the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.
- 8. A candidate appointed in accordance with rule 4 shall during his stipulated period of service on contractual basis, be required to undergo prison staff training and pass the post- training examination in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Prisons Staff Training Rules, 1981.

- 9. A candidate appointed in accordance with rule 4 shall after regular appointment be required to pass the departmental examination and an examination in Hindi or Gujarati or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
- 10. A candidate appointed by direct selection shall have to undergo such training and pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.
- 11. A candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.

Minimum Physical Standards for the post of Jailor Group-II (Male), Class III,

Norms to be taken into consideration by the Medical Officer:

Minimum expansion of chest when inflated shall not be less than 5 centimeters.

- (iii) SHAPEI means- S F'sychological
 - H Hearing
 - A Appendage

P Physical capacity for normal work

- E Eye sight
 - Mean fit in all respect to perform normal professional functions under each or the above mentioned heads.
- (iv) The candidates shall be free from surgical deformities like knock-knees, flat-foot and shall not have a past history of fits or psychiatric ai ments, Vericosevein, etc.
