Gujarat Home Guards Act,1947. No. GG/33/12/HGD/102003/5025(1)//F:- In exercise of the powered conferred by clause (c) of section 8 of the Gujarat Home Guards Act, 1947 (Bom. III of 1947) and in supresession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Government of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating the recruitment to the post of Deputy Commandant General- Cum-Joint Director, Civil Defence, Class I in the Home Guards Organisation, Gujarat State namely:-

- 1. These rules may be called the Deputy Commandant General-Cum-Joint Director, Civil Defence, Class I, in the Home Guards Organisation, Recruitment Rules, 2012.
- 2. Appointment to the post of Deputy Commandant General-Cum-Joint Director, Civil Defence, Class I, in the Home Guards Organisation, shall be made either,-
 - (a) by promotion of a person on the basis of principle of selectivity within the zone of consideration irrespective of seniority in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967, from amongst the persons who.
 - i) have worked for not less than five years in the cadre of Battalion Commandant, Class I, in the Border Wing, Home Guards Organisation.

- ii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006;
- iii) possess a valid Light Motor Vehicle driving licence for a period of not less than two years as on the date of promotion; and
- iv) fulfill the requisite criteria of physical fitness as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time:

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience specified in clause (i) is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up the post by promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period, it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two thirds of the period as specified in clause (i);

or

- **(b)** by direct selection.
- **3.** To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall;-
 - (a) not be more than 42 years of age:

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate belonging to Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes or Socially and Educationally Backward Classes and in favour of a candidate who is woman and in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;

(b) possess-

- (i) a degree obtained from any of the Universities or an institutions established or incorporated by or under the Central or State Act, in India, or any other educational institution recognised as such by the Government or declared to be deemed as University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; or possess an equivalent qualification recognized as such by the Government;
- (ii) the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;
- (iii) a valid Light Motor Vehicle driving licence for a period of not less than two years as on the date of appointment;
- (c) (i) have experience of five years service in the Army as a regular Commissioned Officer holding a rank not lower than the rank of a Colonel or its equivalent in Air force or Navy, or;

- (ii) have experience of five years in Para Military Force such as Border Security Force or Central Reserve Police Force or State Reserve Police Battalion etc. on the post of Senior Superintendent of Police or its equivalent;
- (d) fulfill the requisite criteria of physical fitness specified in Appendix appended to these rules;
- (e) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both,
- 4. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of two years.
- 5. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period, be required to undergo pre-service trainings and pass the post training examination in accordance with the provisions of the Gazetted Officers Pre-Service Training and Examination Rules, 1970.
- 6. A candidate appointed by direct selection shall during his probation period be required to pass the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.
- 7. A candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to pass an examination in Gujarati or Hind or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government in that behalf from time to time.
- **8.** A candidate appointed either by direct selection or by promotion shall have to undergo such training and pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time.

9. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish a security and surety bonds in such form, for such period, and for such amount as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time.

(C) Candidates having any one or more of the following physical defects shall not be considered fit for the post, namely:-

knock knee, pigeon Chest, Squint Eye, Flat Feet, Varicose Veins, Hammer Tees, Fractured Limb, Decayed Teeth, Communicable or Skin Disease.

- (D) The medical Board shall, examine the Candidate and issue the Certificate of physical fitness taking into Consideration the Physical Standards as mentioned above and also certify for the following matters, namely:

H Hearing

A Appendage

P Physical capacity for normal work

E Eye sight

I means fit in all respects to perform normal professional functions each of the above Mentioned heads.
